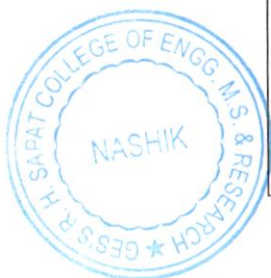

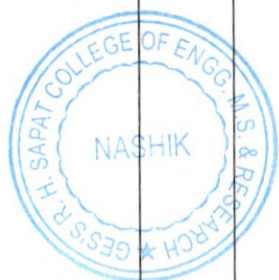
Following activities were conducted by the Electrical Engineering Department
